

Gender Specific Approaches: *Engaging women in the Criminal Justice System*

Over the last 12 months, TWP has been delivering Gender Specific Mentoring training to organisations and individuals interested in developing mentoring schemes for women. Using experience and evidence, TWP delivered 8 training workshops with other 100 participants attending from 78 different organisations.

Together Women Project, Yorkshire and Humberside also offers training workshops to organisations, professionals and volunteers working with women involved in the Criminal Justice System. The aim of the training is to explore effective ways of engaging, motivating and empowering women who have been affected by the Criminal Justice System.

Training can be offered in half day or one day workshops. Training is delivered informally and encourages discussion and group work. Bespoke training is available and can be designed to best suit the needs of participants.

Training topics can include:

- Profile of women in the Criminal Justice System
 - Elements of a gender specific approach
- Gender inclusion policy and development
 - Identifying and assessing need
 - Support planning
 - Pathways to reduce re-offending
 - Volunteering and peer mentoring
